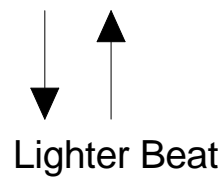
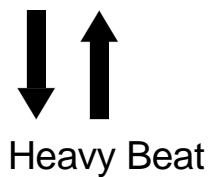


Jig Variation 1

Standard Jig in 6:8 time with emphasis on the 1st (down) and 4th (up) beats but skipping beat 2
